



FIRST COMMUNION

First Communion Mass:

May 4th (Spanish) @ 1pm **or** **May 5th (English) @ 9am**

Both child and sponsor should arrive one hour before their assigned Mass time. We will meet in the Holy Family Hall (Gym).

- **Sponsors:**
 - **MUST RECEIVE COMMUNION!**
Confession times at OLV are:
 - *Tuesdays 5 p.m.-6:45 p.m.*
 - *Thursdays 7:30 am-8 a.m.*
 - *Saturday 3:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. in the Chapel.*
 - Only first Communicant and sponsor(s) sit together in the reserved area. Parents and other family may sit anywhere in the church not marked “reserved”.
 - Must dress appropriately for Mass. No short skirts and low tops, no saggy bottoms, no hats for men/boys and no rosaries around the neck.
 - No eating 1 hour before Communion.
 - No chewing gum
- **Pictures:**
 - A professional photographer will be present to take pictures *before, during and after* Masses. Forms for photos will be available to you on the day of *First Communion Practice*. A basket will be available to hand in your forms on the day of event.
 - Parents are responsible for picking up pictures. It will be announced at Mass and on the OLV website when pictures are ready – it takes about 2-3 weeks.
 - Please take pictures **after** Mass.
- **Other:**
 - It is not required for the child to bring a bible, rosary or a candle as it will not be used during Mass. However, you may bring these items (optional) and get them blessed by the priest afterwards.

Dress Code for First Communion

- Boys: White shirt, dress pants (suit jackets & white tuxedos are optional)
- Girls: White dress, veil and gloves are optional
